

Fayoum and Alexandria Extension:

01 Day 1Cairo

Arrive in Cairo and transfer to your hotel.

Fairmont Nile Plaza

02 Day 2 Cairo – Fayoum Oases

Morning drive 60 miles southwest of Cairo to colorful Tunis village, well known for its exquisite pottery, where we check in to our luxury boutique hotel overlooking Qaroun lake. Visit Dimeh Al-Siba “Dimeh of the lions”, a Ptolemaic city believed to be founded by Ptolemy II in the 3rd century BC. Next we visit Qasr el Sagaa temple and the petrified forest of Fayoum. Lunch at Qatrani camp followed by a visit to the Ptolemaic Palace of Qasr Qaroun temple. If time permits, sunset felluca ride at Qaroun lake.

03 Day 3 Fayoum

Morning visit to Wadi el Rayan waterfall, considered to be the largest waterfall in Egypt, and Magic Lake where the waters seemingly change color as the sunlight changes. Drive to Wadi Al-Hitan, Valley of the Whales, a paleontological site rich in hundreds of invaluable fossils remains of the earliest, and now extinct whales. After lunch we visit Qusoor el Arab camp, nomads cave, followed by a traditional Bedouin dinner and show.

05 DAY – Alexandria

Visit Pompey's pillar, believed to have contained the ashes of Pompey, one of the generals of the Roman army. This area is also believed to be the site of the original library of Alexandria. Visit the Catacombs of Alexandria, a private

Roman tomb which later became a public burial place bearing the characteristics of the transformation of Egyptian art into Roman art. Visit to the Greco-Roman Theatre and the Excavations that reveals the Old City of Alexandria. Afternoon visit to the Alexandria National Museum to see the [monuments](#) that have been recovered from the Mediterranean Sea.

06 DAY – Alexandria

[Visit the New Alexandria Library](#) & Kayet Bay fortress from the Mameluke period (15th century). This fortress was once the foundation of the famous lighthouse of Alexandria (one of the seven wonders of the ancient world). Enjoy lunch at the nearby Tikka Grill. This restaurant is known for the fresh seafood & other typical Egyptian dishes.
