


#### DAY 5 - ASWAN

In the morning, Sail to Kom Ombo. Visit on the way the temple of Kom Ombo dedicated to Sobek the Crocodile god and Hours the falcon god. Continue sailing to Edfu. After Lunch visit to the Temple of Horus, this temple was dedicated to the union of Hathour and Horus. Overnight at Esna.
